Refugee fairness Policy checklist* ***Our reasonable, practical and achievable demands***

- ✓ Permanent end to offshore detention and processing
- ✓ Replace temporary visas with a pathway to permanency and citizenship
- ✓ Repeal cuts to Status Resolution Support Services (SRSS) payments
- ✓ Increase Australia's refugee and humanitarian intake

Greens

- ✓ End offshore detention on Manus Island and Nauru, bring every detainee to Australia
- ✓ Abolish Temporary Protection Visas, reintroduce Permanent Protection Visas
- ✓ Provide fair support for people seeking asylum living in the community - work rights, legal representation and support payments equal to Newstart

Labor

- ✗ Maintain offshore processing
- ✓ Accept New Zealand's offer to take 150 refugees
- ✓ Abolish temporary visas and transition eligible refugees onto permanent visas
- ✓ Allow means tested access to funded migration assistance and social services

Liberal

- ✗ Maintain offshore detention and processing
- ✗ Keep 'fast-track' assessments and current temporary visa policy
- ✗ Continue reduced SRSS payments

Independent & minor parties

Approach candidates directly to clarify if their refugee policy supports 'fair not fear'.
